

1 A bill to be entitled  
 2 An act relating to road designations; designating Andrew  
 3 J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp, Jose Regueiro Avenue, Manuel  
 4 Capo Boulevard, Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial  
 5 Highway, Cuban-American Association of Civil Engineers  
 6 Way, Biscayne Park Way, Dr. Oscar Elias Biscet Boulevard,  
 7 and Father Gerard Jean-Juste Street in Miami-Dade County;  
 8 amending s. 17, ch. 2008-256, Laws of Florida; revising  
 9 the designation of Jose A. Marques Boulevard in Miami-Dade  
 10 County; designating Verna Bell Way in Nassau County;  
 11 directing the Department of Transportation to erect  
 12 suitable markers; designating a portion of S.W. 67th  
 13 Avenue in Miami-Dade County as a state historic road;  
 14 restricting use of public funds for projects related to  
 15 such road; providing for construction; providing an  
 16 effective date.

 18 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 20 Section 1. Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp designated;  
 21 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

22 (1) The ramp that connects northbound Homestead Extension  
 23 of Florida's Turnpike to northbound Interstate 75 in Miami-Dade  
 24 County is designated as "Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp."

25 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 26 suitable markers designating Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp  
 27 as described in subsection (1).

28 Section 2. Jose Regueiro Avenue designated; Department of

29 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

30 (1) That portion of W. 20th Avenue in the City of Hialeah  
 31 between W. 44th Place and Okeechobee Road in Miami-Dade County  
 32 is designated as "Jose Regueiro Avenue."

33 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 34 suitable markers designating Jose Regueiro Avenue as described  
 35 in subsection (1).

36 Section 3. Manuel Capo Boulevard designated; Department of  
 37 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

38 (1) That portion of S.W. 8th Street between S.W. 24th  
 39 Avenue and S.W. 27th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated  
 40 as "Manuel Capo Boulevard."

41 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 42 suitable markers designating Manuel Capo Boulevard as described  
 43 in subsection (1).

44 Section 4. Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway  
 45 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
 46 markers.-

47 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 1, also known as State  
 48 Road 5, between S.W. 104th Street and S.W. 112th Street in  
 49 Miami-Dade County is designated as "Lt. Colonel Charles Brown  
 50 Memorial Highway."

51 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 52 suitable markers designating Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial  
 53 Highway as described in subsection (1).

54 Section 5. Cuban-American Association of Civil Engineers  
 55 Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
 56 markers.-

57 (1) That portion of N.W. 107th Avenue between Flagler  
 58 Street and N.W. 7th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as  
 59 "Cuban-American Association of Civil Engineers Way."

60 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 61 suitable markers designating Cuban-American Association of Civil  
 62 Engineers Way as described in subsection (1).

63 Section 6. Biscayne Park Way designated; Department of  
 64 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

65 (1) That portion of N.E. 6th Avenue between N.E. 113th  
 66 Street and N.E. 121st Street in Miami-Dade County is designated  
 67 as "Biscayne Park Way."

68 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 69 suitable markers designating Biscayne Park Way as described in  
 70 subsection (1).

71 Section 7. Dr. Oscar Elias Biscet Boulevard designated;  
 72 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

73 (1) That portion of Coral Way between S.W. 32nd Avenue and  
 74 S.W. 37th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Dr.  
 75 Oscar Elias Biscet Boulevard."

76 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 77 suitable markers designating Dr. Oscar Elias Biscet Boulevard as  
 78 described in subsection (1).

79 Section 8. Father Gerard Jean-Juste Street; Department of  
 80 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

81 (1) That portion of 54th Street between N.W. 5th Court and  
 82 N.E. 5th Avenue in Little Haiti in Miami-Dade County is  
 83 designated as "Father Gerard Jean-Juste Street."

84 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect

85 suitable markers designating Father Gerard Jean-Juste Street as  
 86 described in subsection (1).

87 Section 9. Section 17 of chapter 2008-256, Laws of  
 88 Florida, is amended to read:

89 Section 17. Dr. Jose A. Marques Boulevard designated;  
 90 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

91 (1) That portion of 8th Street between S.W. 107th Avenue  
 92 and S.W. 127th ~~117th~~ Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated  
 93 as "Dr. Jose A. Marques Boulevard."

94 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 95 suitable markers designating Dr. Jose A. Marques Boulevard as  
 96 described in subsection (1).

97 Section 10. Verna Bell Way designated; Department of  
 98 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

99 (1) That portion of State Road 200 between Lime Street and  
 100 Beech Street in the City of Fernandina Beach in Nassau County is  
 101 designated as "Verna Bell Way."

102 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect  
 103 suitable markers designating Verna Bell Way as described in  
 104 subsection (1).

105 Section 11. That portion of S.W. 67th Avenue, also known  
 106 as Ludlam Road, between Bird Road and S.W. 136th Street in the  
 107 City of South Miami and the Village of Pinecrest in Miami-Dade  
 108 County is designated as a state historic road. No public funds  
 109 shall be expended for any of the following purposes:

110 (1) To cut or remove any tree having a diameter at its  
 111 thickest part in excess of 6 inches within 35 feet of either  
 112 side of the paved surface of the road or to engage in an

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113 activity which requires the removal without the replacement of  
114 such tree.

115 (2) The alteration of the physical dimensions or location  
116 of S.W. 67th Avenue, the median strip thereof, or the land  
117 adjacent thereto, except:

118 (a) Routine or emergency utilities maintenance activities  
119 necessitated to maintain the road as a utility corridor.

120 (b) Modifications or improvements made to provide for  
121 vehicular ingress and egress of governmental safety vehicles.

122 (c) Alterations, modifications, or improvements made for  
123 the purpose of enhancing life safety vehicular use or pedestrian  
124 use, or both, of S.W. 67th Avenue, as long as such alterations,  
125 modifications, or improvements are heard in a public hearing and  
126 subsequently approved by the governing board of the local  
127 government in which such alterations, modifications, or  
128 improvements are located.

129 (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent  
130 the ordinary maintenance and repair of the road or structures,  
131 provided the physical dimensions and location of the road and  
132 the appearance of any structure are preserved. However, the  
133 preservation of the road shall take priority over considerations  
134 of traffic management, and the public safety shall not be  
135 construed to require alterations in the road when alternative  
136 means promoting safety, including more restrictive traffic  
137 regulations, are available.

138 Section 12. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
