Subsection (7) is added to section 206.9825, Florida Statutes, to read: 206.9825 Aviation fuel tax.-(7) (a) A commercial airline that purchases aviation fuel that is placed into an aircraft owned by the airline while the aircraft is in the state capital may obtain a refund of the tax imposed in paragraph (1)(a) if: 1. The commercial airline has a ticket counter presence in the state capital. The aircraft is refueled in connection with a flight 2. that embarks or disembarks passengers in the state capital.
