4 Remove lines 110-121 and insert:

5 (b) The Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Florida  
6 shall retain all revenues from the sale of such plates until all  
7 startup costs for developing and issuing the plates have been  
8 recovered. Thereafter, 60 percent shall be distributed to the  
9 Veterans of Foreign Wars, Department of Florida to support the  
10 Voice of Democracy and Patriots' Pen Scholarship programs, to  
11 support high school and college ROTC programs, and for  
12 administration and marketing the plate; 20 percent shall be  
13 distributed to the direct-support organization created under s.  
14 292.055 under the Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs; and  
15 20 percent shall be distributed to the direct-support  
16 organization created under s. 250.115 under the Florida
