4 Between lines 263 and 264, insert:

5 Section 10. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer
6 Services shall meet with duly authorized representatives of
7 established organizations representing the state's pest control
8 industry and shall prepare and submit a report to the President
9 of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
10 chair of the Senate Committee on Agriculture, and the chair of
11 the House Committee on Agribusiness by January 1, 2011. The
12 report shall include recommended amendments to chapter 482,
13 Florida Statutes, that provide for disciplinary action to be
14 taken against licensees who violate laws or rules pertaining to
15 the pretreatment of soil to protect newly constructed homes,
16 pest control at sensitive facilities such as schools and nursing

17 homes, and the fumigation of existing homes for protection
18 against termite damage, thereby providing additional safeguards
19 for consumers. The report may also address other issues of
20 concern to the department and to members of the industry, such
21 as changes to requirements for professional liability insurance
22 coverage or the amount of bond required, duties and
23 responsibilities of a certified operator, issuance of a
24 centralized pest control service center license, and limited
25 certification for commercial wildlife management personnel.

36 the department and members of the industry;
