10	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

12	Section 1. Any financial institution that institutes a
13	foreclosure proceeding against a residential property or has a
14	foreclosure proceeding pending against residential property
15	shall timely pay all fees associated with or owed by that
16	property, including, but not limited to, homeowners' association
17	fees, maintenance fees, and property taxes. The financial
18	institution shall pay such fees accruing from the date on which
19	the foreclosure action is initiated through the date on which
20	the foreclosure is finalized. This section applies:
21	(1) Retroactively to all foreclosure proceedings pending
22	as of the effective date of this act.
23	(2) To all foreclosure proceedings initiated on or after
24	the effective date of this act.
25	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
