A bill to be entitled

An act relating to appropriations; providing an appropriation to the Grants and Donations Trust Fund within the Agency for Health Care Administration for use in the Medicaid program and Low-Income Pool Program; providing a contingency for the transfer of funds from the low-income pool; providing for a portion of the appropriation to be used as the state match for the disproportionate share hospital programs and as payments to Shands Teaching Hospital to continue the original purpose of providing health care services to indigent patients through Shands HealthCare System; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) For the 2010-2011 fiscal year only, the sum of \$9,673,569 of recurring funds is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Agency for Health Care

 Administration as grants and aids for the Shands Teaching

 Hospital. Such funds shall be primarily designated for transfer to the Grants and Donations Trust Fund within the Agency for Health Care Administration for use in the Medicaid program or Low-Income Pool Program.
- (2) Of the funds appropriated in this section, \$3,820,670 may be used in the Low-Income Pool Program or as funding to buy back the Medicaid inpatient and outpatient trend adjustments applied to Shands HealthCare System's individual hospital rates

and other Medicaid reductions to their rates up to the actual Medicaid inpatient and outpatient costs. The transfer of the funds from the low-income pool is contingent upon another local government or health care taxing district providing an equivalent amount of funds to be used in the Low-Income Pool Program.

- (3) Of the funds appropriated in this section, \$5,852,899 may be used as the state match for the disproportionate share hospital programs funded in Specific Appropriation 190 of chapter 2010-152, Laws of Florida.
- Administration cannot use the full amount of the funds
 appropriated in this section as directed in subsections (2) and
 (3), the remaining funds may be used secondarily for payments to
 Shands Teaching Hospital to continue the original purpose of
 providing health care services to indigent patients through
 Shands HealthCare System.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
