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a permit to drill in the Gulf of Mexico and may make other

evaluations requested by the department. The membership of the

task force shall be composed as follows:

- (a) The State Geologist, who shall serve as chair.
- (b) A representative of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.
  - (c) A representative from the oil industry.
  - (d) A representative from an organized conservation group.
- (e) A botanist.

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- (f) A hydrologist.
- (g) A master gardener.
- (3) The task force shall administer this section pursuant to the laws of the state and the rules and orders of the department which apply generally to regulation of the production of oil and gas. If site-specific conditions require, the task force may recommend that additional procedures, safeguards, or conditions that are necessary to protect the integrity of the Florida coast of the Gulf of Mexico be required as a condition to the issuance of a permit to drill and produce in waters of the gulf under state jurisdiction.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
