(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Article III of the
State Constitution, the Florida Drug, Device, and Cosmetic Trust
Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1,
2015. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be
reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida
Statutes.
Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, except
that this act shall not take effect unless it is enacted by a
three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the
Legislature.
