2 An act relating to interstate health insurance policies; 3 creating s. 624.122, F.S.; authorizing solicitation and 4 sale of interstate health insurance policies in this state 5 by certain persons; providing a definition; requiring 6 interstate health insurance policies and policy 7 applications to contain a certain notice; providing for 8 application of certain provisions to certain insurers; 9 excluding interstate health insurance policies from 10 certain requirements; exempting interstate health 11 insurance policies and applications from certain Florida Insurance Code provisions; providing exceptions; providing 12 an effective date. 13

WHEREAS, while many residents of this state have access to first-rate health care, affordable health care coverage is not available to all who wish to purchase it, and

18 WHEREAS, by removing barriers limiting access to affordable 19 health care coverage and expanding opportunities for residents 20 of this state to purchase more affordable coverage, this state 21 can improve access to health care and curtail rising health care 22 costs while preserving the first-rate care that so many 23 Floridians already enjoy, and

Section 624.122, Florida Statutes, is created 33 to read: 34 624.122 Interstate health insurance policies; notice; 35 exemption.-36 (1) Interstate health insurance policies and applications 37 may be solicited and sold in this state only by a licensed health insurance agent and underwritten only by an admitted 38 39 insurer. For purposes of this subsection, the term "interstate 40 health insurance policy" means a policy of health insurance 41 providing creditable coverage as defined in s. 627.6561(5)(a)2. 42 that is offered to an individual who is a resident of this state 43 and the policy is governed by the laws of any state, district, 44 or commonwealth of the United States other than this state. 45 (2) Any interstate health insurance policy sold, and any 46 application for such insurance provided to a resident of this 47 state pursuant to this section, must contain the following 48 conspicuous, boldfaced disclosure in at least 12-point type: 49 50 THIS INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY IS PRIMARILY 51 GOVERNED BY THE LAWS OF ... Health 73 insurance agents who are licensed and appointed pursuant to 74 chapter 626 may solicit, sell, effect, collect premium on, and 75 deliver interstate heath insurance policies in accordance with 76 this section. 77 Any interstate health insurance policy or application (4) 78 solicited, provided, entered into, issued, or delivered pursuant 79 to this section is exempt from all provisions of the Florida Insurance Code, except that such policy, contract, or agreement 80 is subject to the provisions of ss. 624.155, 624.316, 624.3161, 81 626.951, 626.9511, 626.9521, 626.9541, 626.9551, 626.9561, 82 626.9571, 626.9581, 626.9591, 626.9601, 627.413, 627.4145, 83 84 627.428, and 627.6043.
