A bill to be entitled

An act relating to operating grants for public libraries; amending s. 257.17, F.S.; authorizing the Department of State to waive certain operating-grant eligibility requirements for a specified period of time for a library administrative unit located in a rural area of critical economic concern; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 257.17, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

257.17 Operating grants.—A political subdivision that has been designated by a county or municipality as the single library administrative unit is eligible to receive from the state an annual operating grant of not more than 25 percent of all local funds expended by that political subdivision during the second preceding fiscal year for the operation and maintenance of a library, under the following conditions:

- (2) The library established or maintained by such political subdivision shall:
- (a) Be operated under a single administrative head who is an employee of the single library administrative unit and who has completed a library education program accredited by the American Library Association. The single administrative head shall have at least 2 years of full-time paid professional experience, after completing the library education program, in a public library that is open to the public for a minimum of 40

The department may waive the requirements of 31 this paragraph for a period not to exceed 4 years on behalf of a 32 single library administrative unit in a county or municipality 33 that is designated as a rural area of critical economic concern pursuant to s. 288.0656 and is unable to employ an 34 35 administrative head who meets the requirements of this 36 paragraph. 37

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
