Any party who fails to provide the required information commits a 58 noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a nonmoving 59 violation as provided in chapter 318, unless the officer 60 61 determines that due to injuries or other special circumstances such insurance information cannot be provided immediately. If 62 63 the person provides the law enforcement agency, within 24 hours 64 after the crash, proof of insurance that was valid at the time of the crash, the law enforcement agency may void the citation. 65
