Senate Substitute for Amendment (528984) (with title amendment)

Between lines 2121 and 2122 insert:

Section 53. Section 322.145, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

322.145 Electronic authentication of licenses.-

(1) Any driver's license issued on or after July 1, 2012, must contain a means of electronic authentication, which conforms to a recognized standard for such authentication, such as public key infrastructure, symmetric key algorithms, security

tokens, mediametrics, or biometrics. Electronic authentication capabilities must not interfere with or change the driver's license format or topology.

- (2) The department shall provide, at the applicant's option and at the time a license is issued, a security token that can be electronically authenticated through a personal computer. The token must also conform to one of the standards provided subsection (1).
- (3) The department shall negotiate a new contract with the vendor selected to implement the electronic authentication feature which provides that the vendor pay all costs of implementing the system. This contract must not conflict with current contractual arrangements for the issuance of driver's licenses.
