8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

10 Section 1. Subsection (16) of section 847.001, Florida
11 Statutes, is amended to read:

12 847.001 Definitions.—As used in this chapter, the term:
13 (16) "Sexual conduct" means actual or simulated sexual
14 intercourse, deviate sexual intercourse, sexual bestiality,
15 masturbation, or sadomasochistic abuse; actual or simulated lewd
16 exhibition of the genitals; actual or simulated physical contact
17 with a person's clothed or unclothed genitals, pubic area,
18 buttocks, or, if such person is a female, breast with the intent
19 to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of either party; or any
20 actual or simulated act or conduct which constitutes sexual
21 battery or simulates that sexual battery is being or will be
22 committed. A mother's breastfeeding of her baby does not under
23 any circumstance constitute "sexual conduct."

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
