7 400.0246 Reporting of criminal conduct on premises;
8 destruction of evidence prohibited.—An employee or officer of a
9 nursing home shall report any criminal conduct witnessed or
10 learned of subsequent to its occurrence to local law enforcement
11 prior to reporting the conduct to the employer, a supervisor, or
12 a director. Every effort must be made to preserve all evidence
13 relating to the crime. Any person who destroys evidence commits
14 a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s.
15 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
