A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the decennial census; amending s.

11.031, F.S.; requiring the Legislature to adjust federal decennial census figures to include prisoners in the geographic areas where they last resided before incarceration rather than the facility where they were residing at the time of the federal census; creating s.

944.805, F.S.; requiring the Department of Corrections to provide a report to the Legislature listing certain information relating to prisoners in state correctional institutions and federal facilities; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 11.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

11.031 Official census.-

(1) All acts of the Florida Legislature based upon population and all constitutional apportionments shall be based upon the last federal decennial statewide census as adjusted under this subsection. For each prisoner included in the report submitted by the Department of Corrections pursuant to s.

944.805, the Legislature shall determine the geographic units for which population counts are reported in the federal decennial census which contain the last address where the prisoner resided before incarceration. If that address is in this state, the Legislature shall:

(a) Adjust all relevant population counts reported in the census, including populations by age, gender, and race as if the person resided at that address on the day the census reports population.

- (b) Eliminate the person from all applicable population counts reported in the census for the geographic units in this state which include the state correctional institution or federal facility for which the census reports population.
- Section 2. Section 944.805, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
 - 944.805 Decennial census of prison population.-
- (1) By June 1 of the year in which the federal decennial census is conducted, the Department of Corrections shall submit a report to the Legislature containing the following information:
- (a) The name of each prisoner incarcerated in a state correctional institution or federal facility located in this state on the date the census reports population who completed a census form, responded to a census inquiry, or is included in any report provided to census officials, if the form, response, or report indicates that the prisoner resides at the correctional institution or federal facility.
- (b) The age, gender, and race of each prisoner included in the report.
- (c) The location of the state correctional institution or federal facility where the prisoner is residing on the date the population is counted.
 - (d) The last address where the prisoner resided before his

(2) The Secretary of Corrections shall request each agency that operates a federal facility in this state which incarcerates prisoners convicted of a federal criminal offense to provide a report that includes the information listed in subsection (1) for each prisoner residing at the facility.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
