An act relating to Brevard County; authorizing the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation to issue an alcoholic beverage license to the Brevard Art Museum, Inc., for use within the museum's buildings; requiring payment of a license fee; providing for the sale of beverages for consumption at the museum; providing for transfer of the license; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation is authorized, upon application, to issue an alcoholic beverage license in accordance with s. 561.17, Florida Statutes, to the Brevard Art Museum, Inc., a corporation not for profit (the "corporation") located in Brevard County, for use by the corporation within the museum's buildings located at 1463 and 1520 Highland Avenue in Melbourne. The corporation shall pay the applicable license fee provided in s. 565.02, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Alcoholic beverages may be sold by the corporation for consumption at the Brevard Art Museum. The license issued pursuant to this act does not permit the sale of alcoholic beverages in sealed containers for consumption outside the Brevard Art Museum.

Section 3. The corporation may transfer the license from

time to time to qualified applicants who are authorized by or
under contract with the corporation to provide food services at
the Brevard Art Museum. Upon termination of a transferee's
authorization or contract, the license shall automatically
revert by operation of law to the corporation.
Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
