6 Section 79. Subsections (5), (6), and (7) are added to
7 section 316.0083, Florida Statutes, to read:

8 316.0083 Mark Wandall Traffic Safety Program;
9 administration; report.-

10 (5) Prior to installing a traffic infraction detector the
11 department, a county, or a municipality must request that the
12 Department of Transportation perform a safety hazard study for
13 the intersection. The department, a county, or a municipality
14 shall be responsible for the cost of the study. A traffic
15 infraction detector shall not be installed until the Department

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16 of Transportation has performed the study and determined that
17 the intersection warrants a traffic infraction detector.

18 (6) A safety hazard study required under this section
19 shall evaluate the safety of an intersection within a 6-month
20 period. A safety hazard exists if, at the end of the study
21 period, the Department of Transportation identifies a
22 statistically disproportionate number of motor vehicle crashes
23 at the intersection, greater than that of similarly situated
24 intersections in the county or municipality.

25 (7) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the department, a
26 county, or a municipality shall not use a traffic infraction
27 detector to issue citations for violations committed by a motor
28 vehicle making a right-hand turn.
