52 (d) (c) Each party to the crash must shall provide the law 53 enforcement officer with proof of insurance, which must to be included in the crash report. If a law enforcement officer 54 55 submits a report on the accident, proof of insurance must be 56 provided to the officer by each party involved in the crash. Any 57 party who fails to provide the required information commits a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a nonmoving 58 violation as provided in chapter 318, unless the officer 59 determines that due to injuries or other special circumstances 60 61 such insurance information cannot be provided immediately. If 62 the person provides the law enforcement agency, within 24 hours 63 after the crash, proof of insurance that was valid at the time 64 of the crash, the law enforcement agency may void the citation.

(e) (d) The driver of a vehicle that was in any manner 65 66 involved in a crash resulting in damage to any vehicle or other 67 property in an amount of \$500 or more, which $\frac{1}{2}$ was not 68 investigated by a law enforcement agency $_{\tau}$ shall, within 10 days 69 after the crash, submit a written report of the crash to the 70 department or traffic records center.
