8 (1) Effective October 1, 2011, the presence of each 9 resident in a facility shall be covered by a <u>state-approved</u> 10 contract, executed by the licensee and the resident or his or 11 her designee or legal representative at the time of admission or 12 prior thereto and at the expiration of the term of a previous 13 contract, and modified by the licensee and the resident or his

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14	or her designee or legal representative at the time the source
15	of payment for the resident's care changes. Each party to the
16	contract is entitled to a duplicate original thereof, printed in
17	boldfaced type, and the licensee shall keep on file all
18	contracts which it has with residents. The licensee may not
19	destroy or otherwise dispose of any such contract until 5 years
20	after its expiration or such longer period as may be provided in
21	the rules of the agency. Microfilmed records or records
22	reproduced by a similar process of duplication may be kept in
23	lieu of the original records.
