Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Alex Brown Act." Section 2. Section 316.0075, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.0075 Operator use of commercial mobile radio services and electronic communications devices.—

- (1) Regulation of operator or passenger use of commercial mobile radio services and other electronic communications devices in a motor vehicle is expressly preempted to the state.
- (2) (a) A person who has not attained 18 years of age and is driving or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle on the roads of this state may not use any type of handheld cellular telephone or other handheld electronic communications device.
 - (b) This subsection does not apply:
- 1. To a device that is designed for hands-free use and the person is using it in that manner.
- 2. When the motor vehicle is stopped and the engine is not running.
- (c) A violation of this subsection is a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a moving violation as provided in

chapter 318. Upon a second or subsequent violation of this

subsection, in addition to the penalties for a moving violation

under chapter 318, the department shall suspend the person's

driver's license and privilege to drive for a period of 6

months.
