5 Section 2. Subsections (5), (6), and (7) are added to
6 section 316.0083, Florida Statutes, to read:

7 316.0083 Mark Wandall Traffic Safety Program;
8 administration; report.-

9 (5) Prior to installing a traffic infraction detector the
10 department, a county, or a municipality must request that the
11 Department of Transportation perform a safety hazard study for
12 the intersection. The department, a county, or a municipality
13 shall be responsible for the cost of the study. A traffic
14 infraction detector shall not be installed until the Department
15 of Transportation has performed the study and determined that
16 the intersection warrants a traffic infraction detector.

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17 (6) A safety hazard study required under this section
18 shall evaluate the safety of an intersection within a six-month
19 period. A safety hazard exists if, at the end of the study
20 period, the Department of Transportation identifies a
21 statistically disproportionate number of motor vehicle crashes
22 at the intersection, greater than that of similarly situated
23 intersections in the county or municipality.

24 (7) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the department, a
25 county, or a municipality shall not use a traffic infraction
26 detector to issue violations committed by a motor vehicle making
27 a right-hand turn.

32 Remove line 9 and insert:

33 the act; amending s. 316.0083, F.S. requiring the Department of
34 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, a municipality or county to
35 request the Department of Transportation perform a safety hazard
36 study before installing a traffic infraction detector; providing
37 for the cost of the study; providing that a traffic infraction
38 detector may not be installed unless it is determined to be
39 warranted; providing requirements for the safety hazard study;
40 providing that traffic infraction detectors may not be used to
41 issue certain violations; providing an effective date.
