insert:

Section 5. Subsection (3) of section 170.01, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

170.01 Authority for providing improvements and levying and
collecting special assessments against property benefited.—

(3) Any municipality, subject to the approval by ~~of~~ a
majority vote of the affected property owners voting in an
election, may levy and collect special assessments against
property benefited for the purpose of stabilizing and improving:

(a) Retail business districts,
