19	WHEREAS, the majority of Americans are unaware of their
20	risk factors for a stroke and are unaware of the signs and
21	symptoms of an impending stroke, and
22	WHEREAS, statistics show that African Americans have almost
23	twice the risk of a first stroke compared to Caucasians,
24	primarily because of their increased risk of hypertension, high
25	cholesterol, and diabetes, and
26	WHEREAS, the American Stroke Association in 2008 launched
27	the "Power to End Stroke" campaign, the goal of which is to
28	educate and empower African Americans, as well as those of other
