10	Section 1. Subsection (6) is added to section 322.12,
11	Florida Statutes, to read:
12	322.12 Examination of applicants
13	(6) Each examination given for a Class E driver's license
14	or a commercial driver's license under this section must include
15	one question testing the applicant's knowledge of traffic
16	regulations to assist blind persons. To pass the examination,
17	the applicant must answer that question on the examination
18	correctly. In developing questions under this subsection, the
19	department shall emphasize pedestrian right of way when a driver
20	is making a right turn at an intersection.
21	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
