Section 6. Subsection (1) of section 464.203, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

464.203 Certified nursing assistants; certification requirement.-

9 (1) The board shall issue a certificate to practice as a 10 certified nursing assistant to any person who demonstrates a 11 minimum competency to read and write and successfully passes the 12 required background screening pursuant to s. 400.215. If the 13 person has successfully passed the required background screening Florida Senate - 2011 Bill No. CS for SB 1992

14 pursuant to s. 400.215 or s. 408.809 within 90 days before applying for a certificate to practice, the board shall waive 15 16 the requirement that the applicant successfully pass an additional background screening pursuant to s. 400.215. The 17 18 person must also meet and meets one of the following 19 requirements: 20 (a) Has successfully completed an approved training program and achieved a minimum score, established by rule of the board, 21 22 on the nursing assistant competency examination, which consists 23 of a written portion and skills-demonstration portion approved by the board and administered at a site and by personnel 24 25 approved by the department. (b) Has achieved a minimum score, established by rule of 26 27 the board, on the nursing assistant competency examination, which consists of a written portion and skills-demonstration 28 29 portion, approved by the board and administered at a site and by 30 personnel approved by the department and: 1. Has a high school diploma, or its equivalent; or 31 32 2. Is at least 18 years of age. 33 (c) Is currently certified in another state; is listed on

that state's certified nursing assistant registry; and has not been found to have committed abuse, neglect, or exploitation in that state.

(d) Has completed the curriculum developed under the Enterprise Florida Jobs and Education Partnership Grant and achieved a minimum score, established by rule of the board, on the nursing assistant competency examination, which consists of a written portion and skills-demonstration portion, approved by the board and administered at a site and by personnel approved Florida Senate - 2011 Bill No. CS for SB 1992
