Section 1. Section 409.1757, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

409.1757 Persons not required to be refingerprinted or rescreened.—Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, human resource personnel who have been fingerprinted or screened pursuant to chapters 393, 394, 397, 402, and this chapter, ~~and~~ teachers who have been fingerprinted pursuant to chapter 1012, and law enforcement officers who meet the requirements of s. 943.13, who have not been unemployed for

14 more than 90 days thereafter, and who under the penalty of
15 perjury attest to the completion of such fingerprinting or
16 screening and to compliance with ~~the provisions of~~ this section
17 and the standards for good moral character as contained in such
18 provisions as ss. 110.1127(3), 393.0655(1), 394.457(6), 397.451,
19 402.305(2), ~~and~~ 409.175(6), and 943.13(7), are ~~shall~~ not be
