Section 1. Subsection (1), paragraph (c) of subsection (5), and subsection (12) of section 790.06, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.-

(1) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is authorized to issue licenses to carry concealed weapons or concealed firearms to persons qualified as provided in this

13 section. Each such license must bear a color photograph of the 14 licensee. For the purposes of this section, concealed weapons or 15 concealed firearms are defined as a handgun, electronic weapon or device, tear gas gun, knife, or billie, but the term does not 16 include a machine gun as defined in s. 790.001(9). Such licenses 17 shall be valid throughout the state for a period of 7 years from 18 19 the date of issuance. Any person in compliance with the terms of such license may carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm 20 21 notwithstanding the provisions of s. 790.01, or may carry openly 22 notwithstanding s. 790.053. The licensee must carry the license, 23 together with valid identification, at all times in which the 24 licensee is in actual possession of a concealed weapon or 25 firearm and must display both the license and proper 26 identification upon demand by a law enforcement officer.
