 An act relating to violations of injunctions for
 protection; amending s. 784.047, F.S.; adding
 circumstances that violate an injunction for
 protection against repeat violence, sexual violence,
 or dating violence; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 784.047, Florida Statutes, is amended to
 read:

784.047 Penalties for violating protective injunction
 against violators.—A person who willfully violates an injunction
 for protection against repeat violence, sexual violence, or
 dating violence, issued pursuant to s. 784.046, or a foreign
 protection order accorded full faith and credit pursuant to s.
 741.315 by:

(1) Refusing to vacate the dwelling that the parties share;

(2) Going to, or being within 500 feet of, the petitioner's
 residence, school, place of employment, or a specified place
 frequented regularly by the petitioner and any named family or
 household member;

(3) Committing an act of repeat violence, sexual violence,
 or dating violence against the petitioner;

(4) Committing any other violation of the injunction
 through an intentional unlawful threat, word, or act to do
 violence to the petitioner; ~~or~~

(5) Telephoning, contacting, or otherwise communicating
 with the petitioner directly or indirectly, unless the

30 injunction specifically allows indirect contact through a third

32 (6) Knowingly and intentionally coming within 100 feet of
33 the petitioner's motor vehicle, whether or not that vehicle is
34 occupied;

35 (7) Defacing or destroying the petitioner's personal
36 property, including the petitioner's motor vehicle; or

37 (8) Refusing to surrender firearms or ammunition if ordered
38 to do so by the court,

40 commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as
41 provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

42 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
