322.21 License fees; procedure for handling and collecting fees.—

- (7) (a) A Any veteran who meets the qualifications in subparagraphs 1.-5. is exempt from all fees required by this section:
 - 1. Has been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces;
- 2. who Has been issued a valid identification card by the Department of Veterans' Affairs in accordance with s. 295.17, or the veteran must provide an official letter from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor stating the percentage of the veteran's service-connected disability and a copy of the veteran's honorable discharge at the time of application for a driver's license or driver's license renewal;
