Section 1. Section 320.0892, Florida Statutes is created to read:

320.0892 Motor vehicle license plates to recipients of the Silver Star.—Any United States citizen who is a resident of

Florida and who was awarded the Silver Star while serving as a

member of the United States Armed Forces may, upon application to the department, be issued a license plate on which is stamped

the words "Silver Star" followed by the serial number. Upon

submission of the application and proof that the applicant meets

the qualifications of this section, the plate shall be issued

without payment of the license tax imposed by s. 320.08.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
