A bill to be entitled

An act relating to publication or statement of state sponsorship; repealing s. 286.25, F.S., which requires a nongovernmental organization that sponsors a program financed partially by state funds or funds obtained from a state agency to provide disclosure of such sponsorship in a specified manner; amending s. 409.1671, F.S.; revising provisions which require lead community-based providers of foster care and related services to include notice of state sponsorship in contracts and other written documents to conform to the repeal of s. 286.25, F.S.; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Section 286.25, Florida Statutes, is repealed.</u>
Section 2. Subsection (16) of section 409.1671, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

409.1671 Foster care and related services; outsourcing.-

(16) A lead community-based provider and its subcontractors <u>must include</u> are exempt from including in written contracts and other written documents the statement "sponsored by the State of Florida" or the logo of the Department of Children and Family Services <u>if</u>, otherwise required in s. 286.25, unless the lead community-based provider or its subcontractors receive more than 35 percent of their total funding from the state.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.

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
