- (2) The design of corporate license plates must be approved by the department and must have the word "Florida" at the top. Corporate license plates may be personalized as provided in s. 320.0805 but must be approved by the corporate sponsor and the department before issuance.
- (3) A vehicle owner may apply for a corporate license plate for any motor vehicle registered in the owner's name weighing 7,999 pounds or less and also registered as a privateuse vehicle. Each application must be accompanied by an application fee that is 50 percent less than the current registration fee. The application by any vehicle owner for a corporate license plate shall, upon acceptance, authorize the department to provide the applicant's name and address to the corporate sponsor in compliance with s. 119.0712(2). Upon approval of the application, the corporate sponsor shall immediately remit to the department a fee of no less than \$75. The department shall issue the appropriate corporate plate to the vehicle owner, along with a registration and decal, and the registration is valid for one registration period, which may not exceed 15 months. All applicable registration fees authorized by this chapter shall be distributed as provided in this chapter from the proceeds of the fees paid pursuant to this subsection. Excess revenues remaining after the distribution of all required fees shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund to fund the general operations of the department.
