Senator Lynn moved the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 115 - 116 and insert:

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(4) (a) The Department of Children and Family Services shall phase in the implementation of the drug-screening program for persons applying for TANF benefits.

- (b) Before implementing the statewide drug-screening program, the department shall conduct a drug-screening pilot program during the 2011-2012 fiscal year to determine the feasibility of managing a statewide drug-screening program.
- (c) The first phase of implementation shall be a pilot project in one or more counties to demonstrate the feasibility



of managing a statewide drug-screening program. The department shall, when selecting an area to be designated as a model area, give consideration to the urban and rural nature of its TANF recipients.

- (d) Upon demonstration of the feasibility of the first phase of implementation and subject to appropriation of any necessary resources, the department shall develop a detailed implementation plan for the drug testing of TANF applicants.
- (5) The Department of Children and Family Services shall adopt rules as necessary to administer this section.
