Section 2. Eligibility for TANF, food stamps, and other food nutrition programs; drug-related felonies.-A person who is otherwise eligible to receive temporary assistance for needy families (TANF), food stamps, or other food and nutrition assistance is ineligible to receive such assistance if the person has pled guilty or nolo contendere to, or has been found guilty under federal or state law of, any offense that is classified as a felony by federal or state law and that is related to the possession, use, or distribution of a controlled
