An act relating to trust funds; creating the Florida Gaming Trust Fund within the Department of Gaming Control; providing the funding sources and purpose of the trust fund; requiring funds to remain in the trust fund at the end of each fiscal year; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing a contingent effective date.

(1) The Florida Gaming Trust Fund is created within the

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Florida Gaming Trust Fund.-

Department of Gaming Control. Moneys deposited into the fund shall be those collected from sources designated by state law.

The purpose of the trust fund is to provide funding for the regulation of skill-based machine gaming and slot machine gaming.

(2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to s. 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the Florida Gaming Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2015. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, if SB
