SUMMARY ANALYSIS

SB 946 passed the House on March 10, 2011. The bill was approved by the Governor on March 25, 2011, chapter 2011-5, Laws of Florida, and becomes effective July 6, 2011.

This reviser's bill amends sections in the Florida K-20 education code to conform to the directive of the legislature to the Division of Statutory Revision to submit a reviser's bill substituting the term "Florida College System institution" for the terms "Florida college," "community college," and "junior college" where those terms appear in the Florida K-20 education code pursuant to s. 21, ch. 2010-70, Laws of Florida.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
