Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 43.291, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

43.291 Judicial nominating commissions.—

(3) (a) ~~Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,~~
~~each current member of a judicial nominating commission~~
~~appointed directly by the Board of Governors of The Florida Bar~~
~~shall serve the remainder of his or her term, unless removed for~~
~~cause.~~ The terms of all current ~~other~~ members of a judicial
nominating commission are hereby terminated, and the Governor
