(1) When the Legislature authorizes the establishment of a direct-support organization to provide assistance for the museums, the Florida Agriculture in the Classroom Program, the Florida State Collection of Arthropods, the Friends of the Florida State Forests Program of the Florida Forest Service Division of Forestry, and the Forestry Arson Alert Program, and other programs of the department, the following provisions shall 373419

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govern the creation, use, powers, and duties of the direct-support organization: -

- (a) The department shall enter into a memorandum or letter of agreement with the direct-support organization, which shall specify the approval of the department, the powers and duties of the direct-support organization, and rules with which the direct-support organization must shall comply.
- (b) The department may permit, without charge, appropriate use of property, facilities, and personnel of the department by a direct-support organization, subject to the provisions of ss. 570.902 and 570.903. The use shall be directly in keeping with the approved purposes of the direct-support organization and may shall not be made at times or places that would unreasonably interfere with opportunities for the general public to use department facilities for established purposes.
- (c) The department shall prescribe by contract or by rule conditions with which a direct-support organization <u>must shall</u> comply in order to use property, facilities, or personnel of the department or museum. Such rules shall provide for budget and audit review and oversight by the department.
- (d) The department <u>may</u> <u>shall</u> not permit the use of property, facilities, or personnel of the museum, department, or designated program by a direct-support organization <u>that</u> <u>which</u> does not provide equal employment opportunities to all persons regardless of race, color, religion, sex, age, or national origin.
