An act relating to landlord and tenant; amending ss. 810.08 and 810.09, F.S.; allowing a law enforcement officer to remove persons who trespass in a structure or conveyance or on property if the law enforcement officer receives an affidavit from an owner or mortgagee of the property; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 810.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

810.08 Trespass in structure or conveyance.-

- (1) (a) Whoever, without being authorized, licensed, or invited, willfully enters or remains in any structure or conveyance, or, having been authorized, licensed, or invited, is warned by the owner or lessee of the premises, or by a person authorized by the owner or lessee, to depart and refuses to do so, commits the offense of trespass in a structure or conveyance.
- (b) A law enforcement officer in receipt of an affidavit from an owner or a mortgagee of the property may remove a person who is in violation of this section.

Section 2. Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (1) of section 810.09, Florida Statutes, to read:

810.09 Trespass on property other than structure or conveyance.—
