A bill to be entitled An act relating to unclaimed deposits held by utilities; amending s. 717.108, F.S.; requiring that any unclaimed deposits held by a utility be deposited into the Energy Affordability Trust Fund within the Department of Community Affairs for the purpose of supplementing the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program; providing a contingent effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: Section 1. Section 717.108, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 717.108 Deposits held by utilities.-Any deposit, including any interest thereon, made by a subscriber with a utility to secure payment or any sum paid in advance for utility services to be furnished, less any lawful charges, that remains unclaimed by the owner for more than 1 year after termination of the services for which the deposit or advance payment was made is presumed unclaimed. The unclaimed deposits shall be deposited into the Energy Affordability Trust Fund within the Department of Community Affairs for the purpose of supplementing the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, if HB Section 2. 25 809 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is enacted in the same legislative session, or an extension thereof, and becomes law.
