An act relating to public safety telecommunicators;

amending s. 401.465, F.S.; providing for sworn statecertified law enforcement officers to serve as temporary 911 public safety telecommunicators; providing training requirements; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (5) is added to section 401.465, Florida Statutes, to read:
 - 401.465 911 public safety telecommunicator certification.-
- (5) TEMPORARY 911 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATORS; EXCEPTION.-Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a public safety agency may use sworn law enforcement officers as temporary 911 public safety telecommunicators. Any officer who works as a temporary 911 public safety telecommunicator must, within 12 months after first serving as such, successfully complete a supplementary training program for temporary 911 public safety telecommunicators which provides a maximum of 40 hours training and is distributed by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
