7 at a young age, and attended the University of Florida, and

9 World War II and was a participant in two campaigns in the
10 European Theater of Operations, and

11 WHEREAS, upon his return from the military, John Land 12 returned to Apopka, where he went into the manufacturing 13 business before being elected as Mayor of the City of Apopka in 14 1949, a position he held from January 1, 1950, to January 1, 15 1968, and

16 WHEREAS, Mayor John Land was again elected to serve as the 17 Mayor of the City of Apopka in 1970 and he has continued to 18 serve the citizens of Apopka ever since, and

19 WHEREAS, among his many honors during his 58 years as the 20 Mayor of the City of Apopka, Mayor John Land was the recipient 21 of the 1978 Florida League of Cities' E. Harris Drew Municipal 22 Officer of the Year award and was declared to be a "State of 23 Florida Treasure," and

24 WHEREAS, Mayor John Land, the longest-serving mayor in the 25 State of Florida and the longest-serving full-time mayor in the 26 United States of America, holds the honor of being the only 27 elected official in the state who serves on the Board of
