21	prominently displays the name of the charitable organization and
22	the organization's name, logo, trademark or service mark, local
23	physical address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
24	(b) The charitable organization must receive at least 50
25	percent of the personal property deposited into the bins or, if
26	such property is processed and sold by another person or entity
27	that is a for-profit business, the charitable organization must
28	receive at least 50 percent of the proceeds from the sale of
29	such property.

30	(2) As used in this section, the term "unattended donation
31	bin" means a receptacle that is not located adjacent to or on
32	property where the charitable organization operates a facility
33	that is attended during business hours by employees or
34	volunteers of the organization.
