House Resolution

A resolution designating March 31, 2011, as "Civilian Conservation Corps Member Appreciation Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, in the midst of the Great Depression, President Franklin D. Roosevelt's administration created the Office of Emergency Conservation Work, which would later become the Civilian Conservation Corps, in order to provide work for the unemployed in the areas of conservation, restoration, and recreational development of federal and state public lands, and

WHEREAS, in 1934, state officials collaborated with the National Park Service in the acquisition and development of land for state parks and forests, and this endeavor led to the creation of the Florida Park Service and the establishment of Civilian Conservation Corps work camps across the first eight state parks, where employees constructed cabins, picnic pavilions, entrance stations, support buildings, and other recreational facilities, many of which still exist today, and

WHEREAS, the Civilian Conservation Corps employees earned much-needed wages that supported their families as they performed a variety of tasks, including landscaping, reforestation, reintroducing wildlife to depleted areas, constructing and operating fish hatcheries, implementing soil conservation measures, and developing forest firefighting methods, and

WHEREAS, the labor and dedication of the Civilian Conservation Corps nurtured the evolution of Florida's state park system, which now consists of 160 state parks from

Pensacola to Key West, providing the citizens of the state with a vast and flourishing landscape that preserves Florida's unique natural beauty, protects its rich and varied wildlife, and maintains a definitive element of its culture and heritage, and

WHEREAS, modern tenets of conservation are an outgrowth of the work begun by the Civilian Conservation Corps, and its continued dedication to the principles of preservation, conservation, and civil service is an invaluable asset to the ecosystem and residents of Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,
