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1 Representative Schwartz offered the following:

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3 **Amendment to Amendment (382705) (with title amendment)**

4 Remove lines 11-22 of the amendment and insert:

5 (e) The department shall study modifications to the method
6 of expending funds for crisis stabilization services to
7 establish per diem reimbursement for covered services provided
8 to qualified patients. Available funds would be used to
9 reimburse a variety of providers, including public receiving
10 facilities, community mental health programs, licensed acute
11 care hospitals, or other approved facilities. Reimbursement
12 would be limited to appropriated funds. The department shall
13 submit the results of its study, including recommendations, to
14 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
15 Representative by October 1, 2012. Any changes to the payment
16 system needed to implement the results of the study required by
107975

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17 this paragraph may not be implemented until the Legislature
18 makes appropriate modifications to the Baker Act receiving
19 facility designation process.
