164 written request for maintenance of the exemption to the

166 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
167 necessity that the home addresses, telephone numbers, and
168 photographs of county tax collectors, the names, home addresses,
169 telephone numbers, and places of employment of the spouses and
170 children of such tax collectors, and the names and locations of
171 schools and day care facilities attended by the children of such
172 tax collectors be made exempt from public record requirements.
173 It is also the finding of the Legislature that it is a public
174 necessity that the home addresses, telephone numbers, and
175 photographs of current and former investigators and inspectors
176 of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, the
177 names, home addresses, telephone numbers, and places of
178 employment of the spouses and children of such current or former
179 investigators and inspectors, and the names and locations of
