Section 2. Subsection (5) of section 479.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

479.11 Specified signs prohibited.—No sign shall be erected, used, operated, or maintained:

(5) (a) Which displays intermittent lights not embodied in the sign, or any rotating or flashing light within 100 feet of the outside boundary of the right-of-way of any highway on the State Highway System, interstate highway system, or federal-aid primary highway system or which is illuminated in such a manner



so as to cause glare or to impair the vision of motorists or otherwise distract motorists so as to interfere with the motorists' ability to safely operate their vehicles.

(b) If the sign is on the premises of an establishment as provided in s. 479.16(1), in which case the local government authority with jurisdiction over the location of the sign shall enforce the provisions of this section as provided in chapter 162 and this section.
