 20   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 22           Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (8) of section  
 23   322.051, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

26           (b) A capital "V" shall be exhibited on the identification  
 27   card of a veteran upon the payment of an additional \$1 fee for  
 28   the license and the presentation of a copy of the person's DD

29 Form 214, issued by the United States Department of Defense, or  
 30 another acceptable form specified by the Department of Veterans'  
 31 Affairs. Until a veteran's identification card is next renewed,  
 32 the veteran may have the capital "V" designation added to his or  
 33 her identification card upon surrender of his or her current  
 34 identification card, payment of a \$2 fee to be deposited into  
 35 the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund, and presentation of a  
 36 copy of his or her DD Form 214 or another acceptable form  
 37 specified by the Department of Veterans' Affairs. If the  
 38 applicant is not conducting any other transaction, a replacement  
 39 identification card may be issued with the capital "V"  
 40 designation without payment of the fee required in s.  
 41 322.21(1)(f)3.

42 Section 2. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section  
 43 322.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

46 (c) A capital "V" shall be exhibited on the driver  
 47 ~~driver's~~ license of a veteran upon the payment of an additional  
 48 \$1 fee for the license and the presentation of a copy of the  
 49 person's DD Form 214, issued by the United States Department of  
 50 Defense, or another acceptable form specified by the Department  
 51 of Veterans' Affairs. Until a veteran's license is next renewed,  
 52 the veteran may have the capital "V" designation added to his or  
 53 her license upon surrender of his or her current license,  
 54 payment of a \$2 fee to be deposited into the Highway Safety  
 55 Operating Trust Fund, and presentation of a copy of his or her  
 56 DD Form 214 or another acceptable form specified by the

57 Department of Veterans' Affairs. If the applicant is not  
58 conducting any other transaction, a replacement license may be  
59 issued with the capital "V" designation without payment of the  
60 fee required in s. 322.21(1)(e).

61 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
