- (3) The department shall annually report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives the injury and illness data for public employers in the aggregate as well as on a per-public employer basis. Such data shall be published on the department's website.
- (4) Effective October 1, 2012, the department shall establish and publicize on its website, for public employers and employees to access, information related to workplace safety.
