6 provided in subsection (11) if that person, with the intent to
7 injure, defraud, or deceive any insurer:

8 1. Presents or causes to be presented any written or oral
9 statement as part of, or in support of, a claim for payment or
10 other benefit pursuant to an insurance policy or a health
11 maintenance organization subscriber or provider contract,
12 knowing that such statement contains any false, incomplete, or
13 misleading information concerning any fact or thing material to
14 such claim;

15 2. Prepares or makes any written or oral statement that is
16 intended to be presented to any insurer in connection with, or
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17 in support of, any claim for payment or other benefit pursuant
18 to an insurance policy or a health maintenance organization
19 subscriber or provider contract, knowing that such statement
20 contains any false, incomplete, or misleading information
21 concerning any fact or thing material to such claim; ~~or~~

22 3.a. Knowingly presents, causes to be presented, or
23 prepares or makes with knowledge or belief that it will be
24 presented to any insurer, purported insurer, servicing
25 corporation, insurance broker, or insurance agent, or any
26 employee or agent thereof, any false, incomplete, or misleading
27 information or written or oral statement as part of, or in
28 support of, an application for the issuance of, or the rating
29 of, any insurance policy, or a health maintenance organization
30 subscriber or provider contract; or

31 b. ~~Who~~ Knowingly conceals information concerning any fact
32 material to such application; or

33 4. Knowingly presents, causes to be presented, or prepares
34 or makes with knowledge or belief that it will be presented to
35 any insurer a claim for payment or other benefit under a medical
36 care coverage insurance policy if the person knows that the
37 payee knowingly submitted a false, misleading, or fraudulent
38 application or other document when applying for licensure as a
39 health care clinic, seeking an exemption from licensure as a
40 health care clinic, or demonstrating compliance with part X of
41 chapter 400.
